POSTAL BALLOT NOTICE

Pursuant to Section 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014

Dear Member(s),

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to the provisions of Section 110 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 (the “**Act**”), read together with Rules 20 and 22 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (the “**Management Rules**”), (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof for the time being in force) and any other applicable provisions of the Act and the rules made thereunder, read with the General Circular Nos. 14/2020 dated April 8, 2020, 17/2020 dated April 13, 2020, 20/2020 dated May 5, 2020, 22/2020 dated June 15, 2020, 33/2020 dated September 28, 2020, 39/2020 dated December 31, 2020, 10/2021 dated June 23, 2021, 20/2021 dated December 8, 2021, 3/2022 dated May 5, 2022, 11/2022 dated December 28, 2022 and 09/2023 dated September 25, 2023 issued by the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (collectively referred to as “**MCA Circulars**”) and Regulation 44 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (“**SEBI**”) (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, (“**SEBI LODR**”) and other applicable provisions, if any, of the SEBI LODR, for the time being in force and as amended from time-to-time and Secretarial Standard on General Meetings issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India (“**SS-2**”), that the resolution set-out below is proposed to be passed by way of Postal Ballot by voting through electronic means only (“**e-voting**”).

An Explanatory Statement pursuant to Sections 102, 110 and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Act, pertaining to the said resolution setting out the material facts and the reasons thereof is annexed to the Postal Ballot Notice (“**Notice**”), for your consideration.

Pursuant to Rule 22(5) of the Management Rules, Mr. Sridhar Mudaliar (Membership No. FCS 6156), failing him, Mrs. Sheetal Joshi (Membership No. FCS 10480), Partners of M/s. SVD & Associates, Company Secretaries, Pune have been appointed as the “**Scrutinizer**”, to scrutinize the e-voting process in a fair and transparent manner.

The e-voting period commences from Friday, December 22, 2023 at 09.00 a.m. (IST) and ends on Saturday, January 20, 2024 at 05.00 p.m. (IST). Members are requested to peruse the proposed resolution along with the explanatory statement, carefully read the instructions in the Notes to this Notice and cast their vote electronically by indicating Assent (For) or Dissent (Against) for the said Resolution not later than 05:00 p.m. (IST) on Saturday, January 20, 2024 (the last day to cast vote electronically).

Upon completion of the scrutiny of e-voting, the Scrutinizer will submit a report to the Chairman (the “**Chairman**”) or to any other person of the Company duly authorised by the Chairman in this regard, who shall countersign the same. The result of e-voting shall be intimated to BSE Limited and National Stock Exchange of India Limited, where the Company’s equity shares are listed within a period of 2 working days from the conclusion of the e-voting. The results would also be uploaded on the websites of the Company at www.bfutilities.com, the stock exchanges at www.bseindia.com and www.nseindia.com and National Securities Depository Limited (“**NSDL**”) at www.evoting.nsdl.com.

The resolution, if passed by the requisite majority, shall be deemed to have been passed on Saturday, January 20, 2024, i.e. the last date specified for e-voting.

1. Appointment of Mr. Jayant Kumodchandra Hemade (DIN: 10331350) as an Independent Director of the Company

To consider and, if thought fit, to pass, with or without modification(s), the following resolution as a **Special Resolution**:

“RESOLVED THAT pursuant to provisions of Section 149, 150, 152 read with Schedule IV and other applicable provisions, if any, of the Companies Act, 2013 (“the **Act**”), and the Rules made thereunder, applicable provisions of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (the “**SEBI LODR**”), (including any statutory modification(s) or re-enactment(s) thereof for the time being in force), in accordance with the Articles of Association and Nomination and Remuneration Policy of the Company, and pursuant to Recommendation of Nomination and Remuneration Committee and approval of Board of Directors , Mr. Jayant Kumodchandra Hemade (DIN: 10331350), who was appointed by the Board of Directors as an Additional , Non- Executive Independent Director of the Company, with effect from November 29, 2023, in terms of Section 161 of the Act, in respect of whom the Company has received a notice in writing from a member under Section 160 of the Act proposing his candidature for the office of Director, and who has submitted a declaration that he meets the criteria of independence prescribed under Section 149 (6) of the Act and Regulation 16 (1) (b) of the SEBI LODR and being eligible for appointment under the provisions of the Act and the Rules framed thereunder and the SEBI LODR, be and is hereby appointed as an Independent Director of the Company, not liable to retire by rotation, to hold office for a term of 5 (five) consecutive years commencing from November 29, 2023 to November 28, 2028.

1. The Explanatory Statement pursuant to Section 102 read with Section 110 of the Act setting out material facts pertaining to the resolution, is annexed hereto for your consideration and forms part of this Notice.
2. The Notice is being sent to all the members, whose names appear on the Register of Members/ List of Beneficial Owners as on December 15, 2023 as received from NSDL and Central Depository Services (India) Limited (collectively referred to as "Depositories"). In compliance with MCA Circulars, the Notice is being sent to members only in electronic form to the e-mail addresses registered with their Depository Participants (in case of electronic shareholding)/the Company's Registrar and Transfer Agent (in case of physical shareholding). Physical copies of the Notice are not being sent to the members for this Postal Ballot. Therefore, those members who have not yet registered their e-mail addresses are requested to verify / update their e-mail addresses and mobile number with their respective Depository Participants. 3. The Notice is also available on the website of the Company at www.bfutilities.com and on the website of stock exchanges i.e. BSE Limited and the National Stock Exchange of India Limited at www.bseindia.com and www.nseindia.com respectively and on the website of the NSDL i.e. www.evoting.nsdl.com.
4. In compliance with the provisions of Sections 108 and 110 of the Act, read with the Management Rules and Regulation 44 of SEBI LODR, the Company is offering e-voting facility to all the members of the Company to enable them to cast their votes electronically. The Company has engaged the services of NSDL to provide e-voting facility to its members. The instructions for e-voting are annexed to this Notice.
5. The voting rights of the members shall be in proportion to their holding of Equity Shares with the paid-up equity share capital of the Company as on December 15, 2023 ("Cut Off date"). Only those members whose names are recorded in the Register of Members of the Company or in the Register of Beneficial Owners maintained by the Depositories as on the Cut-Off date will be entitled to cast their votes by e-voting. A person who is not a member as on the Cut-Off date should treat this Notice for information purposes only.
6. Facility to exercise vote by Postal Ballot by voting through electronic means will be available during the following period:
 - a) Commencement of e-voting: December 22, 2023 at 09:00 am (I.S.T.)
End of e-voting: January 20, 2024 at 05:00 pm (I.S.T.) (both days inclusive).
 - b) The facility for voting through electronic means will be disabled for voting by NSDL upon expiry of the aforesaid voting period.
7. A member cannot exercise his/her vote through proxy on postal ballot. However, corporate and institutional members shall be entitled to vote through their authorized representatives. Corporate and institutional members are requested to provide a proof of authorization (board resolution /authority letter /power attorney, etc.) in favour of their authorised representatives to the scrutinizer through e-mail to cs@svdandassociates.com with a copy marked to secretarial@bfutilities.com.
8. Members are advised to update their PAN, KYC (Address, Email ID, Mobile Number, Bank Account Details, Specimen Signature, etc.) and Nomination details as mandated by SEBI vide its circular SEBI/HO/MIRSD/MIRSD-PoD-1/P/CIR/2023/37 dated March 16, 2023, to avoid freezing of their folios on or after October 01, 2023, as per below:

Members may further note that SEBI vide circular dated January 25, 2022, has mandated the listed companies to issue securities in dematerialized form only while processing service requests, viz., issue of duplicate securities certificate; claim from unclaimed suspense account; renewal/exchange of securities certificate; endorsement; subdivision/splitting of securities certificate; consolidation of securities certificates/folios; transmission and transposition. 5. Password details for shareholders other than Individual shareholders are given below:

How to cast your vote electronically on NSDL e-Voting system?

1. After successful login at Step 1, you will be able to see all the companies "EVEN" in which you are holding shares and whose voting cycle.
2. Select "EVEN" of company for which you wish to cast your vote during the remote e-Voting period.
3. Now you are ready for e-Voting as the Voting page opens.
4. Cast your vote by selecting appropriate options i.e. assent or dissent, verify/modify the number of shares for which you wish to cast your vote and click on "Submit" and also "Confirm" when prompted.
5. Upon confirmation, the message "Vote cast successfully" will be displayed.
6. You can also take the printout of the votes cast by you by clicking on the print option on the confirmation page.
7. Once you confirm your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.

General Guidelines for shareholders

1. Institutional shareholders (i.e. other than individuals, HUF, NRI etc.) are required to send scanned copy (PDF/JPG Format) of the relevant Board Resolution/ Authority letter etc. with attested specimen signature of the duly authorized signatory(ies) who are authorized to vote, to the Scrutinizer by e-mail to cs@svdandassociates.com with a copy marked to evoting@nsdl.com. Institutional shareholders (i.e. other than individuals, HUF, NRI etc.) can also upload their Board Resolution / Power of Attorney / Authority Letter etc. by clicking on "Upload Board Resolution / Authority Letter" displayed under "e-Voting" tab in their login.
2. It is strongly recommended not to share your password with any other person and take utmost care to keep your password confidential. Login to the e-voting website will be disabled upon five unsuccessful attempts to key in the correct password. [Pursuant to the provisions of Section 102 and Section 110 of the Act and SEBI LODR]

ITEM NO. 1

The Board of Directors (the “**Board**”), on the recommendation of Nomination and Remuneration Committee (the “**NRC**”) had approved the appointment of Mr. Jayant Kumodchandra Hemade as an Additional, Non- executive, Independent director of the Company for a period of five years commencing from November 29, 2023 to November 28, 2028 subject to approval of members of the Company by way of special resolution.

Pursuant to provisions of Section 161 of the Act, Mr. Jayant Kumodchandra Hemade will hold office upto the date of ensuing Annual General Meeting. However, in terms of Regulation 17 (1) (c) of SEBI LODR, approval of members of the Company is required to be obtained for appointment of Director, at the next General Meeting or within a time period of three months, whichever is earlier. Therefore, the approval of members is being sought for aforesaid appointment of Mr. Jayant Kumodchandra Hemade, through postal ballot.

The Company has received a notice in writing from member, in terms of Section 160 of the Act, proposing the appointment of Mr. Jayant Kumodchandra Hemade as Director of the Company.

The Company has received, inter-alia, the following consent, declarations and confirmations from Mr. Jayant Kumodchandra Hemade with regard to proposed appointment:

- a. Consent to act as Director of the Company, in Form DIR 2 in terms of Section 152 of the Act;
- b. Declaration that he is not disqualified from being appointed as Director in terms of Section 164 of the Act;
- c. Declaration that he meets the criteria of Independence prescribed under the Act and SEBI LODR;
- d. Declaration that he is not debarred from holding office of Director by virtue of any order of SEBI or any other such authority;
- e. Confirmation that he is not aware of any circumstance or situation, which exists or may be reasonably anticipated, that could impair or impact his ability to discharge his duties as an Independent Director of the Company;
- f. Confirmation that he has complied with Rule 6 (1) and 6(2) of the Companies (Appointment and Qualification of Directors) Rules, 2014, with respect to Independent Directors Databank.

In opinion of NRC and the Board, Mr. Jayant Kumodchandra Hemade fulfils the conditions of Independence as specified in the Act, the Rules thereunder and SEBI LODR and Independent of the management.

Further in opinion of NRC and the Board, Mr. Jayant Kumodchandra Hemade possess appropriate skills, experience and knowledge required to hold the position of Independent Director of the Company.

Brief Profile of Mr. Jayant Kumodchandra Hemade along with requisite information pursuant to Regulation 36(3) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 along with the skills and capabilities required for the role as Independent Director, is enclosed herewith as **Annexure – A**.

In conformity with Nomination and Remuneration Policy, Mr. Jayant Kumodchandra Hemade will be entitled to receive remuneration by way of sitting fees for attending the meetings of the Board and the Committees thereof of which membership, if any is held by him ,

reimbursement of expenses for participation in the meetings and also commission on annual basis of such sum as may be recommended by the NRC and approved by the Board, subject to overall limits as specified under the Act and rules framed thereunder. Terms and Conditions of appointment are in accordance with Nomination and Remuneration Policy of the Company available on the website www.bfutilities.com

Mr. Jayant Kumodchandra Hemade is not related to any other Director or Key Managerial Personnel of the Company or relatives of Directors or Key Managerial Personnel.
